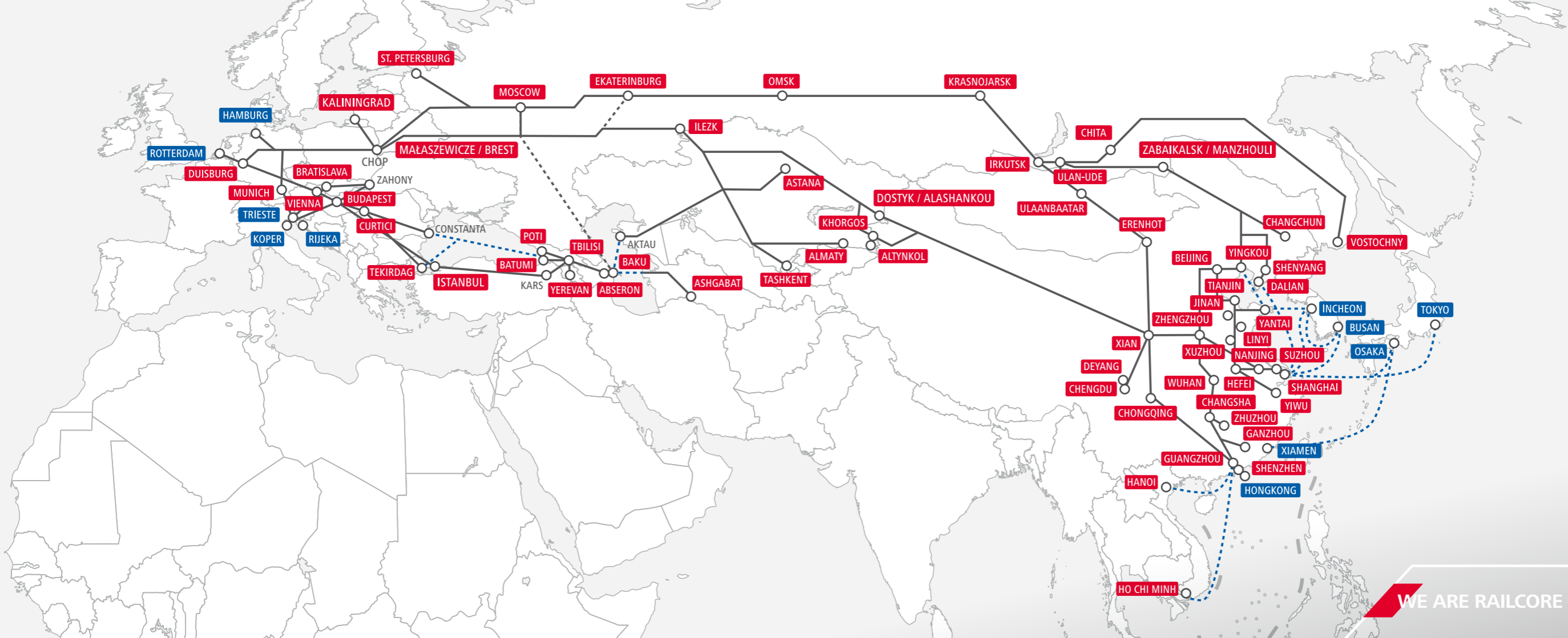

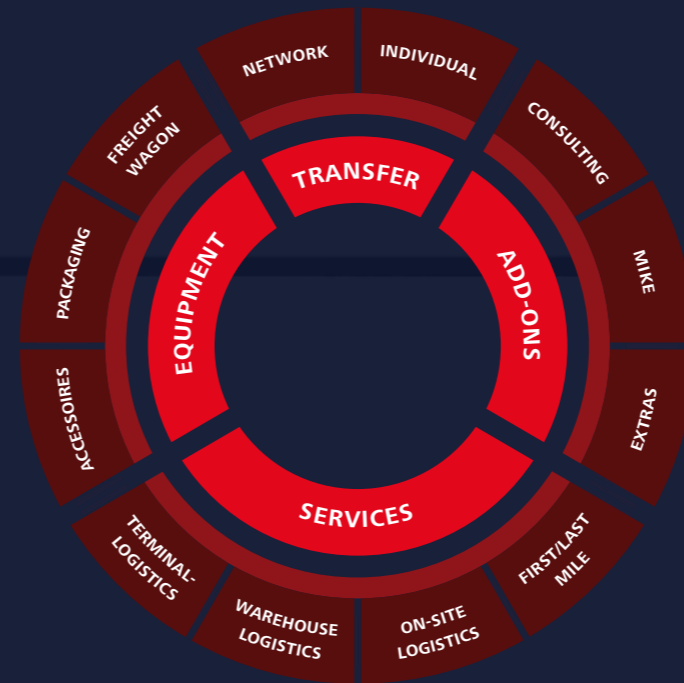

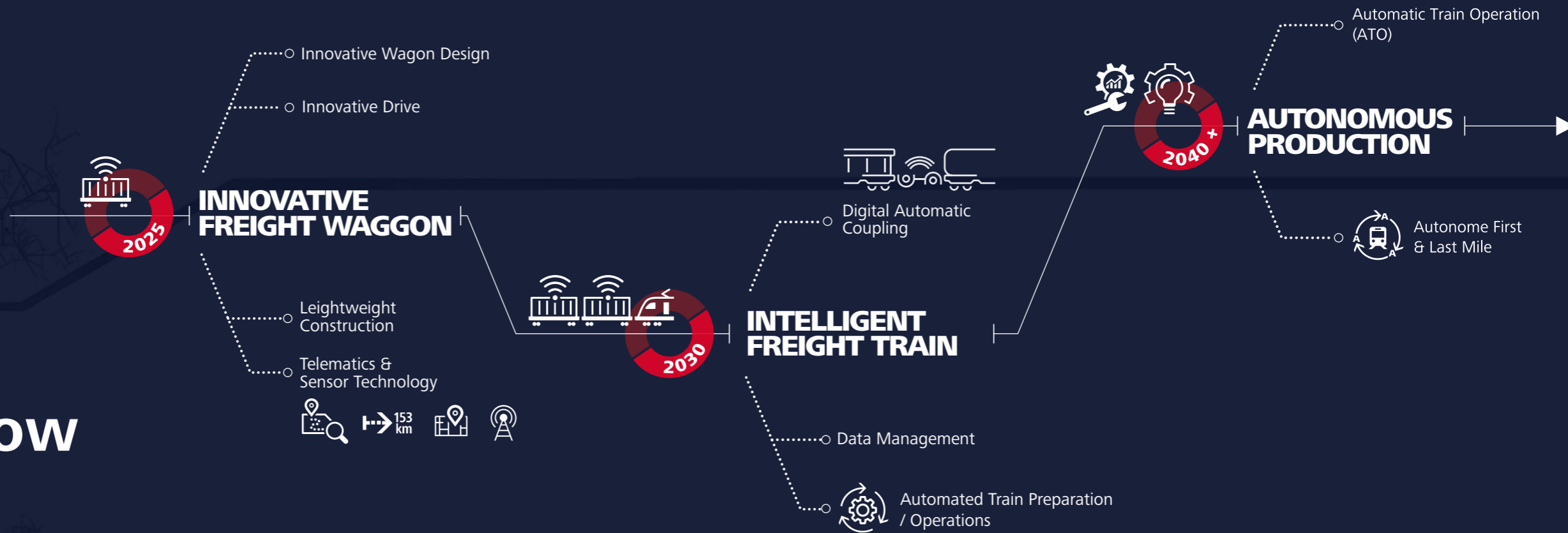


# MIKE – the Digital Logistics Platform

# Sustainable Rail Transport

With every tonne we move by rail, we ensure that the environment continues to breathe easy, as rail freight produces far less CO<sub>2</sub> compared to road freight. The 6 times lower energy consumption and 3 times lower noise levels, combined with 8 times better air quality, make a significant contribution to environmental protection. And thanks to the EcoTransIT World tool, our customers are always aware of their CO<sub>2</sub> savings.



# Environmentally- friendly Initiatives

Two of our three warehouse locations in Austria are certified by ClimatePartner. We are gradually reducing greenhouse gas emissions and investing in climate protection projects to compensate. Furthermore, we also aim to ensure that our traction current comes from clean sources. In Austria, we use 100 % green traction current from renewable energy sources so that we can transport freight to its destination in the most environmentally-friendly way possible.



# Rail Freight Forward

In 2018, together with our partners, we launched the European Rail Freight Forward initiative. Since then, we have been jointly pursuing the goal of shifting 30 % of freight to rail by 2030. To achieve this, we are doing our homework, advocating for coordinated infrastructure across Europe and working with policymakers to ensure fair transport policies and a level playing field.
